Why Read 20 Minutes at Home?

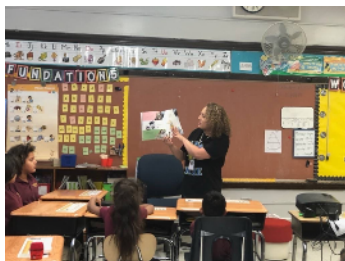
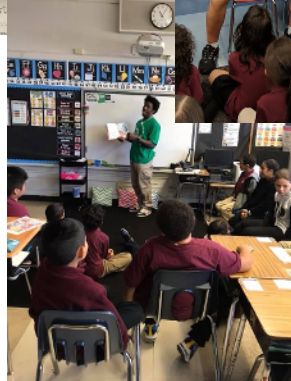
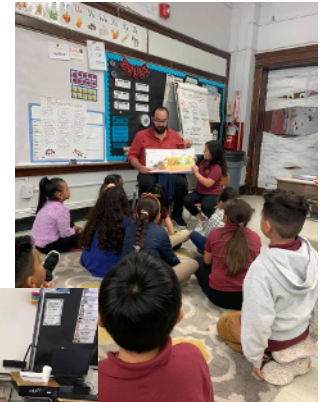
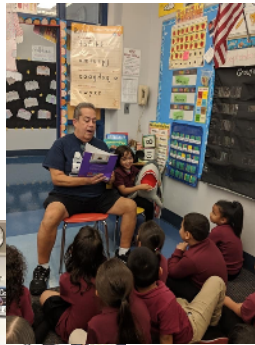
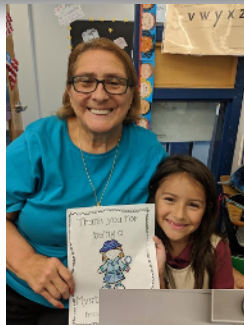

In order for children to become better readers, they need time to read.

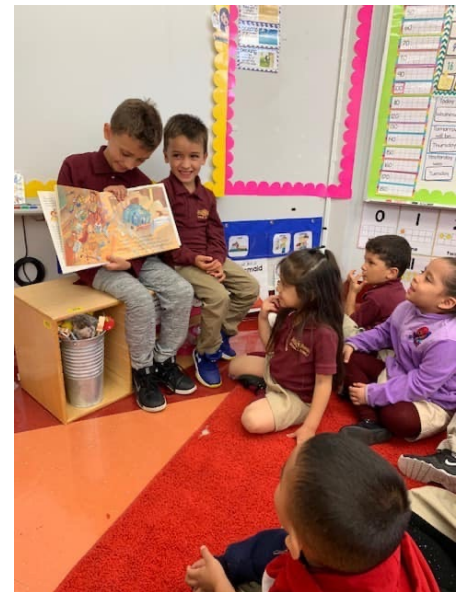
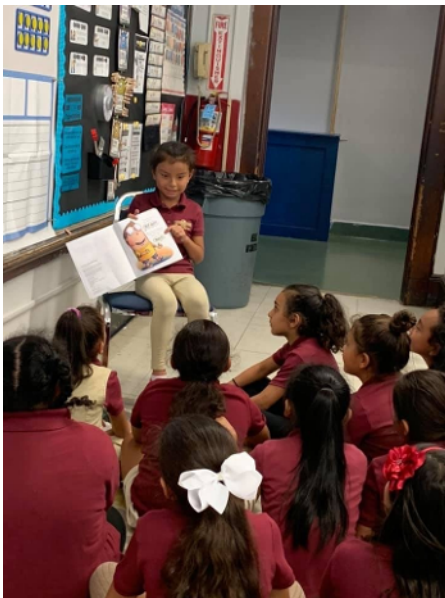
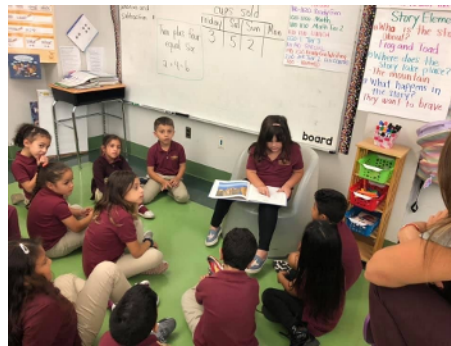
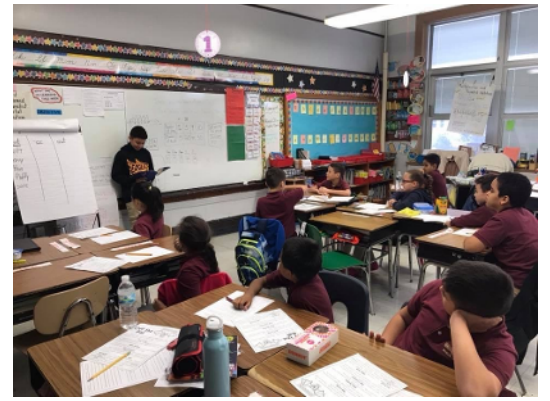

Lincoln School is very fortunate to have such supportive family members that volunteer their time to become a classroom "Mystery Reader"!

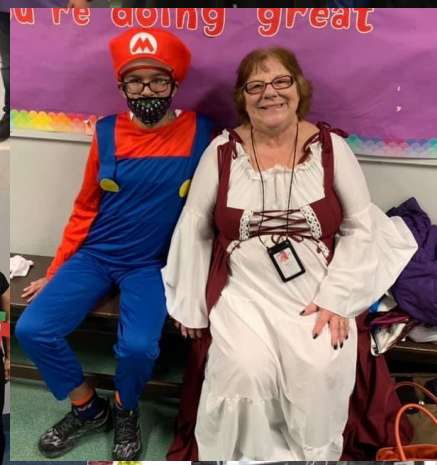


Even our own students have been inspired to become mystery readers themselves!

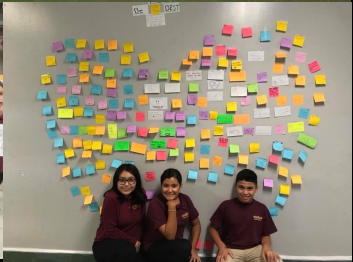
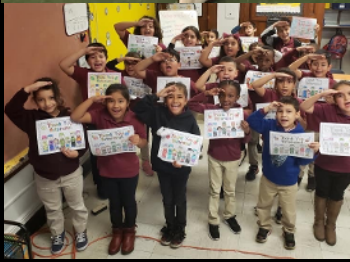
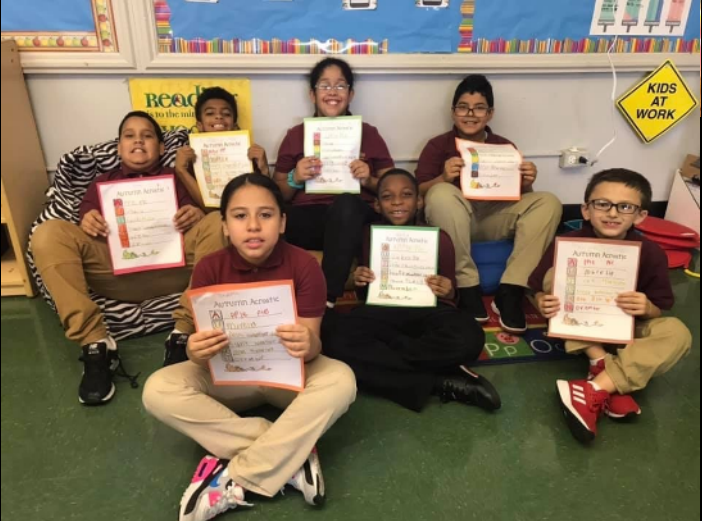
